NEVADA STATE ECOSYSTEM CHART

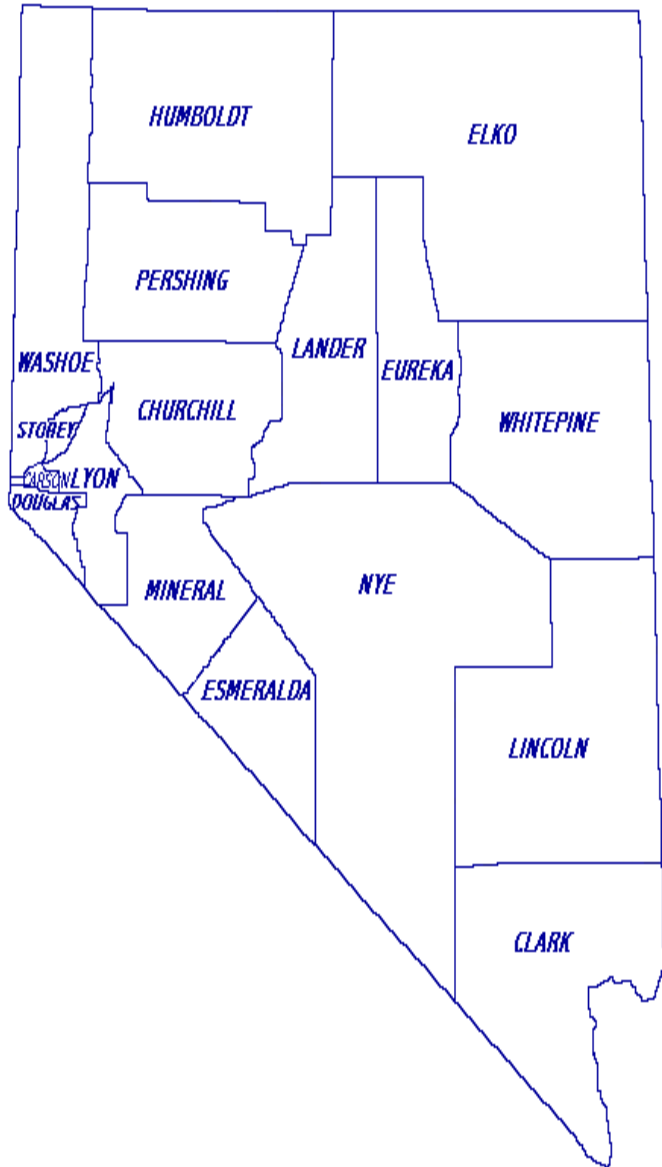
(Flip Chart will be given in the classroom)
